Everman Fire Department is seeking applicants for **Part-time Firefighter/EMT** and **Firefighter/ Paramedic** paid positions (PRN 12 and 24 hr. shifts). Applicants must be currently certified or certifiable as a TCFP Firefighter Basic and TDSHS EMT-Basic or higher at time of application. We offer Competitive Salary and preferred hiring within for all full-time vacancies with additional benefits including: Longevity Pay, TMRS Retirement, Paid Leave, 100% paid Medical/Dental/Vision for employee. Positions listed will remain open until filled.

We are seeking recruits for **compensated and non-compensated** Firefighter positions. Firefighters that meet training requirements are eligible for compensation each 12-hour shift worked. No experience or certifications required to apply. We offer an in-house SFFMA approved Firefighter 1 & 2 academy for all new recruits. With the completion of the academy, you will gain your SFFMA certification and become eligible to challenge the TCFP Firefighter Basic Exam. Classes meet 1-2 days weekly with online testing. We also offer CPR certifications and TDSHS EMR (ECA) classes for all personnel. Next Recruit Academy is scheduled to begin September 2020

### **About Our City and Fire Department**

The City of Everman sits just south of Fort Worth surrounded by Forest Hill, Kennedale, and unincorporated Tarrant County. The city response area is approx. 2 square miles and the population is 7,000 with rapidly increasing daily commuter traffic. Everman Fire Department provides primary fire and EMS response for Tarrant County ESD #1 and surrounding cities mutual aid partners. Annual calls for service total 1200 and increasing every year. The Everman Fire Department is staffed 24/7/365 with 1 Firefighter/EMT, 1 Firefighter/Paramedic and 2 Compensated Firefighter positions. Everman Station 19 houses Medic-19, Engine-19, Tanker-19, Rescue-19 and Brush-19.

- Complete Oral Board and Chief interviews
