Types of Mobile Food Vendors

Prepackaged Food Only

Unit that serves only food that is prepared, packaged in individual servings, transported, and then sold to consumers.

Open and/or Food prep

Unit that serves food that is prepared on the mobile food truck and then sold to consumers.

No food or ingredients shall be stored or prepared at home.


Mobile Food Truck Park

The City of Everman has a mobile food truck park located across the street from Clyde Pittman Park, located in the 300 block of North Race Street. These spaces are available for mobile food trucks who wish to operate in the city on a first come first serve basis, and are required to comply with the City's Mobile Food Truck Ordinance. The following outlines the criteria for obtaining a permit to operate in the City.

License Requirements

Every mobile food truck that operates in the City of Everman is required to obtain a mobile food truck license annually. This license is required to be displayed on truck. The criteria for this license is in accordance with the City's Adopted Mobile Food Truck Ordinance. The following information is required for the license:

- 1. Applicant's name, and business name;
- 2. Valid Driver's license;
- 3. Current registration and liability insurance for the mobile food truck:



- 5. Tax Certificate;
- 6. Sales Tax Reporting signed affidavit from Comptroller;
- 7. Location, name, and address of Central Preparation Facility;
- 8. List of all equipment used on the truck;
- 9. List of food items to be served;
- 10. Copy of Food Manager Certification;
- 11. Photos of the food truck;
- 12. Proof of Health Inspection by the Tarrant County Health Department;
- 13. Proof of fire inspection; and
- 14. Any other information deemed necessary at the time of permitting.



License Determination

Mobile Food Trucks are only allowed in the designated mobile food truck park, therefore space is limited and is first come first serve. Only complete application submittals for a license will be considered in this process for a space at the mobile food truck park.

Mobile Food Truck Park Rules

The following is required of all Mobile Food Trucks in the Mobile Food Truck Park:

- 1. No generator shall be operating after 10 p.m. each night, nor before 7 a.m.;
- 2. All mobile food trucks shall keep their space clean and free of trash or debris;
- 3. A trash receptacle shall be provided for customers;
- 4. Drive-thru service is not permitted;
- 5. Shall comply with all Tarrant County adopted health regulations; and
- 6. Shall comply with all City fire and explosion safety standards.
